



Achieve Stunning Soffit Lighting With LED Strips

Soffits can be made a feature of with LED soffit lights in the form of [LED tape](#). If you want to draw attention to the stone, brickwork or climbing plants on an outdoor wall, having a soffit light in place will certainly do the job.

Whether your property is a contemporary or a traditionally constructed building, soffit lights, easily fitted, will make it noticeable without having to install individual fittings that might take up valuable space. Wall lights can be spectacular and ground based floodlights might also be fantastic, however not every building has the area available for ground or wall mounted fittings. Window bays and sills, signage, hanging baskets or downpipes might prevent you being able to install another form of exterior lighting, but you don't have to be left out. LED soffit lights provide a solution to this problem.

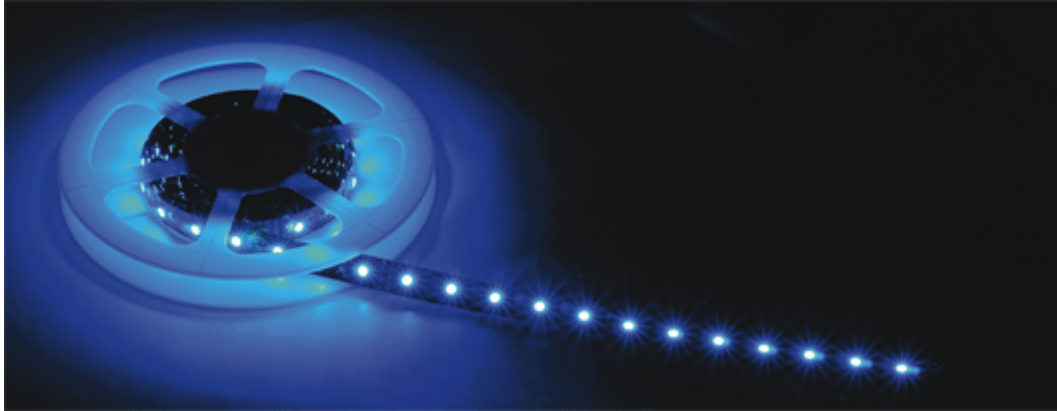
Discreet LED soffit lights can make your property stand out and look welcoming without being 'over the top'. As soffits, the area underside of any element of a building are most commonly found under the roof space on the exterior of the house, waterproof tape is required. Yes, to create a magnificent night time illumination, all you need do is stick these lights in place. The transformation from gloomy to glamorous is easy to do without any need for power tools, nails or screws or specialist equipment.



Imagine coming home or to your place of work, a favourite pub or club and discovering the facelift that could have happened after a morning or an afternoon's effort. Indeed a facelift properly describes what will happen to the exterior façade of your property. It will look brighter, fresher, friendlier and without any obvious cosmetic 'nip and tuck' that would drastically change the features of the building.

Strip lights are usually only available up to 5 metre lengths on websites, but can be supplied as bespoke lengths of 75 metres to run from 1 switch. This is an amazing run length that will offer enough coverage for most buildings, even taking into account the ups and downs of deeply angled eaves that can account for extra distance.

A choice of colours is available to make the outside of the property reflect its own personality or to coordinate with any corporate colour themes for commercial establishments. Green, red and blue or soft white, cool white or gold offer a range of options and if you are undecided, perhaps a changing colour strip to ring the changes and to add a bit of fun to the exterior. This lighting gives a lovely glow around the wall and is great for use on homes and pubs and clubs.



The LED tape comes with a driver (transformer) that connects to the 240 volt mains, then the cables from the other side of the driver connect to the tape and away you go. There are cut points in the tape every 50mm. You then peel off the backing and stick to wherever you are installing the tape. The colour changing type of tape comes with a remote control and infra-red eye that allows you to set it to any colour you want and to flick through an infinite amount of colour combinations.

The high quality 3M adhesive used on the tape is not affected by the moisture so will stay stuck on for a long time and the long lasting 50,000 hour lifespan means there will be no requirement to replace the fitting for 15-20 years. Most properties would consider redecoration after such a length of time, which would be the opportunity for updating your lighting at the same time.
