



Create the Mood and Save Money with LED Downlights in a Restaurant

The correct lighting will make a difference to how your clientele view your restaurant. LED downlights can be the very thing to make the most of your premises as they are affordable enough to make an investment that is versatile and adaptable. The savings that can be made by installing [LED downlights](#) rather than traditional halogen lights are immense.

Based on current figures (2011), there could be an annual saving of £243.95 (over the lifespan of the unit) when you compare a 50 watt halogen downlight fitting with an [Ariel 9](#) watt (50 watt equivalent.) Continuity is important to ensure decorative harmony. With LED downlights gracing your restaurant, you can ring the changes if you opt for the [dimmable](#) variety in your restaurant. A mood can be changed with more subdued lighting or a bright illumination if the occasion calls for it. It can be a lovely idea to dim the lights prior to a presentation of a birthday or anniversary cake when a party are dining in your restaurant. Sympathetic recessed LED restaurant lights add drama and bring a personal touch from the management when catering for special occasion parties.

Restaurant LED lighting will also keep your premises at the correct temperature. Other types of lighting generate heat from their lamps. LED lighting does not. So, there could be extra savings on summer air-conditioning as you won't have to pay for illuminating and cooling at the same time. In restaurant kitchens where a lot of heat builds up, LED lighting could help to contain that too.

Looking good and looking great will set apart one place from another. Recessed LED restaurant lights are easier to keep clean as they don't attract grease or dust in the same way that heat producing bulbs do, which 'cook' the deposits in place. Cool LED lights only need a wipe to keep them clean.

Clear glass lights are best for a bright display and frosted front lamps will produce a light without any glare. Recessed LED restaurant lights are ideal for places that don't have the luxury of high ceilings and the ability to suspend elaborate light fittings. Being flush with the ceiling they won't

clutter the visible space and therefore make it seem larger – without you having to pay for that premium.



Subtly adorning your ceiling, restaurant LED downlights also allow you to change the type of décor if you are updating without having to replace your light fittings, as they behave like a neutral and will complement any theme.
