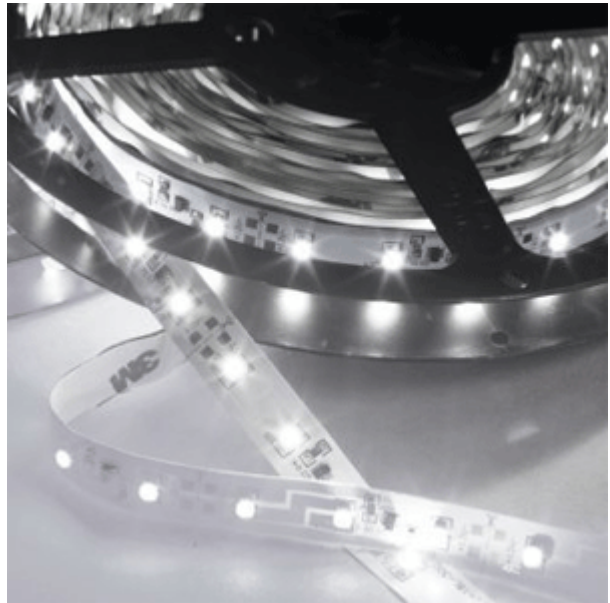




How to Use LED Strip/Tape Lighting in a Motor Home

You've got the vehicle to travel where you want, when you want and freedom is yours. Running a motor home you will appreciate how little things can mean a lot. Motorhome LED lighting is an effective and convenient way of saving space and making the most of your surroundings.

Thin, 8mm wide [LED tape](#) with an adhesive backing is simply installed by sticking it to the surface where you want light to beam from and plugging it in. Using only 4.8 watts per metre your battery won't drain with this 12 volt light strip that is simply – brilliant! Being such a discreet system, it can be tucked under units if you wanted concealed lighting as the lip of cupboard doors will probably hide the thin tape. Even if you chose to adhere the motorhome LED lighting flat against the top of surfaces, it will still be attractive and practical and provide excellent illumination that you can cook or read by.



Not only is the motorhome LED lighting a wonderful addition to the interior of your vehicle, but it can also be used on the exterior – in the [waterproof](#) version. This could be a great way to make your motorhome work better for you. If you have the opportunity to BBQ outside, exterior LED tape lights could ensure you enjoy the evening into darkness without having to worry about hurricane lamps or candles as an alternative lighting method. You could fix the tape on one side or surround it completely. The LED strip lights are available in a range of colours, cool and warm white, gold, red, and yellow, green and blue. There are even [colour changing](#) lights for an attractive, scintillating appearance that can be set to your preferred colour combination within the RGB range.

Motorhome LED lighting saves space. On each metre of LED strip lighting there are 60 individual, high brilliance LEDs. A 12 volt LED strip is economical to run and practical too, simply plug it into your battery and away you go.
