



## **How to get Recessed LED Bathroom Downlight Fittings Right for Your Bathroom**

In a bathroom, often where there are reflective surfaces such as mirrors, tiles and porcelain fittings you can make a real feature of your bathroom lighting. [LED bathroom downlights](#) are available from as low as 3 watts, so if you wanted to create a decorative arrangement to accentuate an architectural feature, you can go to town with LED down lighters.

Bathroom downlights will keep the ceiling free of any obstruction and give an illusion of greater space. Of course, as there is exposure to moisture from steam and splashes, the LED bathroom downlights must be IP rated. Some LED bathroom downlights have the option of being dimmable, but the dimmer switch must be positioned outside of the bathroom. Consider where you put the downlights to avoid shadowing over a mirror and if you need any help we can advise if people are unsure how many downlights they need.



The units for LED bathroom downlights are small enough to position in archways if you have a display shelf that could do with some lighting attention. An ideal worth borrowing from interior designers wanting to make hallways or foyers appear large, is a mirror above a shallow ledge within an archway. Making a recessed mirror and using downlights to illuminate it means you won't ever have shadowing problems as the light surrounds the mirror for uninterrupted illumination. Most bathrooms with families vying for morning use would benefit from a second mirror in a bathroom and the extra reflected bounce of light will make the space seem more airy.

Another reason LED bathroom downlights are a terrific choice, is that they produce very little heat, or none at all, which means if they are used above a display of bathroom lotions and potions they won't affect the contents of the bottles or containers.

Most LED bathroom downlights are available with a silver coloured finish that complements the popular chrome finish on taps and handles found in bathrooms. This continuation of a colour scheme unites the elements and creates a harmonious effect in your décor.

Ceilings and archways aren't the only places where LED lighting can transform a space. The undersides of window soffits are also ideal for this treatment for a decorative application that is functional too. Set slightly forward, out of the way of any rods or fixings, the beam can wash

down the surface of attractive blinds or curtains to show them off and illuminate any objects you might have displayed on the ledge below.
