



How to Use LED Strip/Tape Lighting In and On a Boat

Whether your boat is a pleasure cruiser, a skiff or a barge it is possible to add illumination to the interior and the exterior with LED boat lighting. For those who enjoy fishing at night boats can be fitted with discreet 12 volt [LED strip lights](#) that will offer illumination within the craft, yet won't disturb the water with unwanted reflection. LED boat lighting is achieved with effective waterproof 3M adhesive tape that backs a series of 60 individual LEDs per metre. You can affix a small area near to where you prepare your hooks, perhaps above a seat or the lid of a tackle box to find all the things you need. The lights come with a power supply that takes up only a little room, which could easily be accommodated.

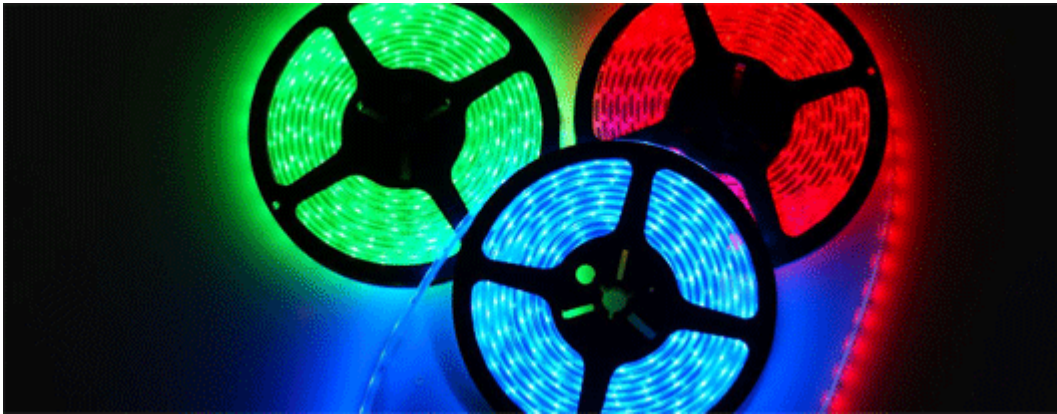


For sailors who spend days and nights on board, LED boat lighting is an ideal solution for providing illumination where storage and display space is at a premium. Lengths of LED boat lighting tape could be adhered to the under surface of units in a cabin, or within coving channels, eliminating the need for occasional or fixed lamps that can take up precious space. Boat LED strip lights are available in a variety of convenient lengths, from 1m to 5m, which have cut off points every 50cm for appropriate application.

Both the interior and the exterior of your boat can benefit from the installation of 12 volt LED strip lights. Any exterior application will require the waterproof version, but this doesn't compromise your options. The same colours are available as well as the popular [colour change](#) boat lighting for a brilliant attractive effect. This lighting can be set to whatever series of colour changes through red/green/blue in whatever combination and duration you choose – and all controlled with an infra-red remote control. You can change the lighting sequence any time you want.

Some commercial customers find that the colour changing lighting strips are very good for sending a 'message', perhaps relating to whether the owner is in or not – a handy way of letting callers know you are not on board, or to advertise any services by incorporating the colours into their timetable or schedule of different trips, outings or activities. For leisure time and those in a party mood, we have supplied some customers with the colour change type of lights for use on the deck area which creates lovely effects at night particularly if they are in a marina and have the lights twinkling through the different colour combinations.

All that's required to have your LED boat lighting up and running is a power source. You connect the strip directly to the 12 volt DC battery and series combinations are possible to design as the tape can be cut at 50cm intervals and be run from an independent on/off switch.
