

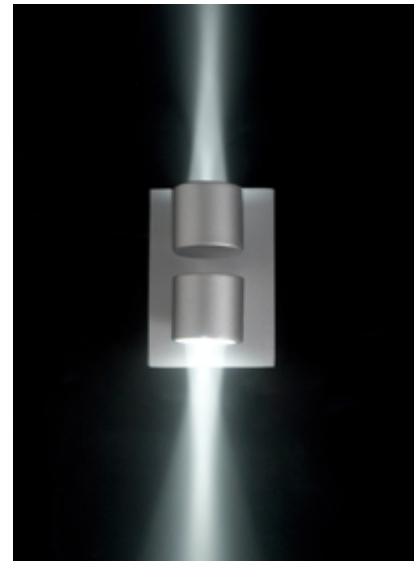


## **LED Outdoor Wall Lights – The Money Saving Option**

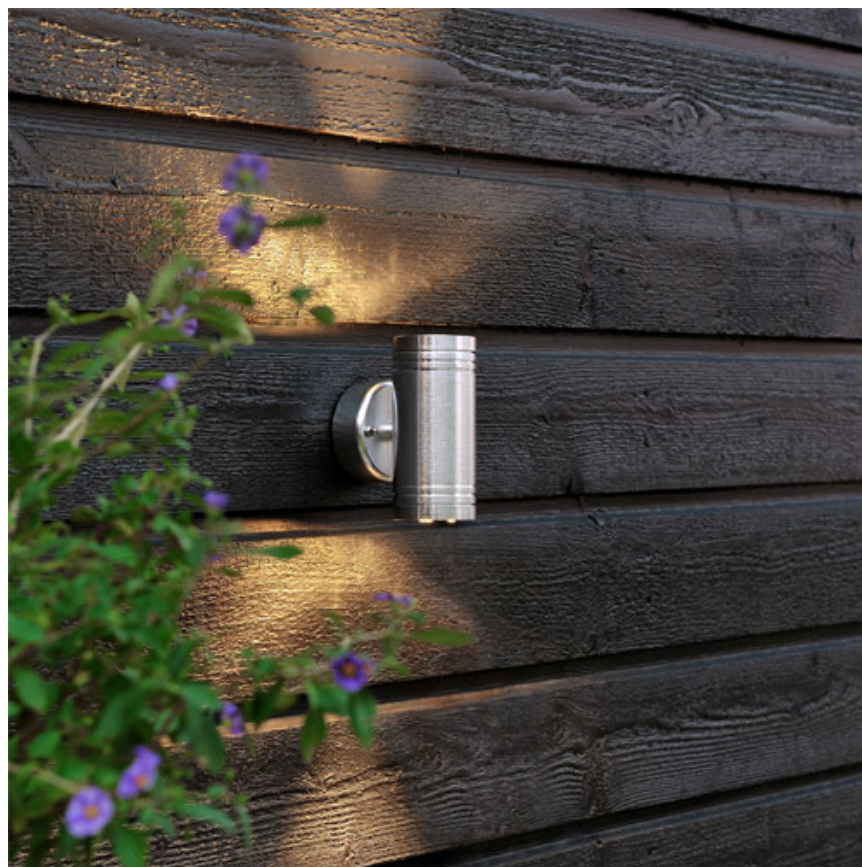

Spikes and floodlights offer opportunity to enhance areas on property frontages, patios or courtyards with illumination to create a wash, shadows or silhouettes from interestingly shaped trees, plants or decoration that is standing nearby, or indeed mounted on the wall.

Another benefit of using LED lights outside on your walls is the compatibility with many other types of garden lighting – bollards, lamp posts, and decking lights, pond and fountain lights – so that your property beams with drama and interest even when it is dark, or visibility is poor. Also, you can crank up the excitement should you ever need to change bulbs by opting for ones with colourful tinges that provide an alternative to white light and can soften the effect by bathing the surroundings in pink, lilac, blue or green. You probably won't have to change your bulb, but perhaps you might just want to ring the changes.
